



ACH-Homeowners are now able to set up an automatic payment through their bank online. All that is needed is a meadowslink.com account.

eCheck- A one-time payment from an owner's bank account via www.meadowslink.com, Pay Here, My Account. This will connect you to MSI's main site.

On-line Bill Pay – One-time payment or recurring payment

- 1) Login to your Meadowslink.com account
- 2) Select Pay Here from the menu at the top of the page.
- 3) Select My Account this is where you will be able to select your payment options.

Please note there is a 3.5% processing fee. It is extremely important to note that if you utilize an online bill pay service your bank does not send a coupon with your payment and it is your responsibility to ensure that your bank or bill pay service includes the proper information.

In Person- You may utilize the Drop Box at The Grange or Taft House 24 hours a day or stop in during business hours.

By Mail with Payment Coupon- Choosing to mail a check accompanied by your assessment payment coupon (if you have chosen ACH you will not have a coupon book). Make your check payable to "The MNC."



Pool Access:

Each pool member has or will need to be registered with The Grange/Taft House and pool fobs can be picked up during regular office hours. As always, owners must be current on assessments in order to enjoy use of the pool. There is no charge for a pool pass if you are a MNC resident. Pool registration is available during regular business hours and will continue throughout the pool season. We will continue using the barcode key fobs given to each and every Meadows resident for pool adminission each and every time you visit the pool. MCA residents interested in purchasing pool passes, please visit Meadowslink.com and click on the Amenities tab. The key fob links each individual to an MNC address by registration information, as well as by picture.

COVID Waivers for 2021 Season: COVID Liability waivers will be required again for the 2021 season. Your 2020 waiver will NOT transfer to the 2021 season and all residents must fill out a waiver again. Any resident over the age of 18 who visits the pool must sign their own waiver. Legal guardians can include their minors on their waiver in the designated area. We are accepting waivers now online or in person at The Grange. Submit your waiver early! Waivers can be found on www.meadowslink.com under the amenities tab and can be emailed to pools@meadowslink.com.

New MNC Homeowner or Resident without a FOB

If you are a new Meadows Neighborhood homeowner, or if adding a new member to your household, or a resident that has not received a key fob yet, please complete a registration form and bring it to The Grange during the times listed and get a picture taken and we will issue each household member a key fob. You may download the registration form from Meadowslink.com. If you have just recently closed on your home, it would be a good idea to bring your closing paperwork, as it can take some time for your information to be entered into our system.

Renters

If you are a renter you will need to provide a current lease and a Consent to Tenant form signed by the property owner or property manager, which provides authorization for renters to use the amenities in place of the owner. There is also an MNC Pool form and a Tentant Use form for the renter to fill out. You may have to provide proof of residency as well. Renters must provide these forms each year. You can use your existing FOBs; we will just reactivate the pass once we receive the forms and the lease. All forms are available online at Meadowslink.com

Are you a MNC resident and already have a key fob? If you are a MNC homeowner, and received a key fob last year, you do not have to do anything for your pool pass except come in and update your children's photos.

SWIM TLC GROUP SWIM LESSONS, CLINICS, PRIVATE AND SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS FOR 2021

Swim TLC will be offering Group Swim Lessons, Clinics, Private and Semi-Private Lessons during the Summer of 2021 at The Grange pool. We are ready for a safe return and will be following COVID-19 precautions recommended by the CDC for both staff and patrons! All lesson coaches will be wearing a face shield during lessons and the facility will be cleaned before and after lessons. Parents or guardians will be asked to social distance from staff and other patrons.

Group Lessons will be based on Swim TLC's 5 Step (levels) Program and will be \$70.00 per week. Group Lessons run for 30 minutes: 8:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. or 9:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m., Monday through Friday on the following weeks: June 7 – 11, June 21 – 25, June 28 – July 2, July 12 – 16 and August 2 – 6. Children must be 3 years of age or older and must be able to participate in lessons without parent involvement. Three Clinics will be offered this summer (Clinics A, B and C) at \$80 each. Clinics run for 1 hour, 8:45 a.m. – 9:45 a.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays on: June 8/10, 15/17; June 22/24, June 29/July 1 and July 13/15, 20/22. Clinics are competitive stroke specific courses. Child will be swimming multiple laps each clinic session.

Private and Semi-Private lessons are available for Children and Adults. Private lessons are \$35 for 30 minutes. Swim TLC is also offering 5 Private Lessons for \$165 or 10 Private Lessons for \$300 (payment in advance). Semi-Privates (2 students of similar ability) are \$50 for both for 30 minutes. 5 Semi-Privates for \$240 or 10 for \$450 (payment in advance). All About Trash

We have a contract with Waste Management for our trash services here in The Meadows Neighborhood Company.

Please make sure all your trash is contained in a Waste Management provided trash bin to allow the truck to pick up the bin and collect the garbage with its mechanized **arms.** This process no longer requires the driver to get out at every house to load up all the trash that is on the curb, therefore making it more efficient. Trash can be put out the evening before pickup and needs to be stored away the evening of pickup. All bins need to be stored in an enclosed structure or appropriately screened from view and only outside at proper pickup times.

Additional bags and boxes full of trash curbside will not get picked up, without calling WM at 303-797-1600 to schedule and pay for the larger trash service.

Cardboard boxes will still be picked up, but they must be flattened and placed next to your bin on either your regular trash day or recycling day. Leaf and yard waste must be disposed of in the bins.

Just a reminder that trash collection is every Friday and recycling is every other Friday. Please see the calendar below for pickups and holidays. This calendar is also available on our website www.meadowslink.com. Any missed pickups reported on Friday prior to close of business, should be

collected on Saturday. If your pickup was inadvertently missed, please contact mweyand@meadowslink.com.

For all issues regarding trash setup, replacement bins or additional bins, please contact mweyand@meadowslink. com. Please note, each household is entitled to 2 trash bins and 2 recycle bins. If you need more than 2 trash bins, or 2 recycle bins, there will be a \$5 monthly fee per bin.

Spring Yard Waste Pick Up

On Friday June 4th, Waste Management will provide a one-time Spring yard waste pick up. They will take up to 10 bags of yard waste and 4 bundles of branches. The yard waste needs to be in bags and branches need to be cute and tied into bundles no longer than 4 feet.

Please Note: Bins that are owned by Waste Management must be left at the property when selling for the next owners to utilize.





their way! We can help migrating
birds by participating in Lights
Out Colorado. The majority of
migrating songbirds travel at
night, and lighting can attract
and disorient birds when they
are migrating. This causes them
to use up the extra energy they
need to get to their next resting
stop-over site where they will
refuel for the next night of migration.



1) turn off decorative and unnecessary lights during the height of bird migration, April-May and August-October, and 2) install shielded outdoor lights to prevent light from being emitted upwards. In addition to helping birds, these efforts reduce energy usage, save money, and can improve safety. Shielded lights create safer conditions for humans, placing the light where it is needed and reducing the glare that prevents our eyes from seeing into the shadows.

You can also keep migrating and resident birds safe by installing bird-friendly window treatments on the exterior of your windows. Highly reflective glass is deadly to birds who see the reflection of trees and sky and fly into windows. It is estimated that 599 million birds die in the U.S. each year from window strikes, most of which happen on the lower stories of buildings while birds forage for food during the day. 

PLANNING AHEAD FOR SPRING PROJECTS – ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW

Beginning in March, the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) started meeting twice a month and will do so through the end of October. During this time frame, the Committee will meet on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of each month, and the deadline for submittals will be the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of the month, respectively. Below is a list of some important items to make sure that your application is included in the ARC meeting.

- Peak season is upon us for all things architectural. It is imperative that you get your completed application submitted by 5:00 p.m. on the due date. It would be prudent to submit the application as early as possible in case there are any additional items that may be needed. An incomplete application will not be included on the agenda.
- Submit your Application and Supporting Documents to the Architectural Committee, by:
 - o **Drop Box:** The Taft House (3570 Celestial Ave.) or The Grange (3692 Meadows Blvd.) You may utilize the Drop Box at The Grange or Taft House 24 hours a day.
 - o Email: ARC@MeadowsLink.com
- The ARC application form can be found on our website at www.meadowslink.com MNC Info Architectural Review Information. The Architectural Guidelines and Fencing Guidelines can also be found in this same location. Copy or print the Application and fill it out completely. Be sure to not leave out any information, as this may slow down the processing of your Application.
- Post-Violation Applications, shall include a \$150 Post Violation Application Fee, if/when they meet certain conditions of non-compliance with the Covenants. Fee is due at the time of submission.
- If you are planning to sell your home in the near future, please refer to the Architectural Guidelines that are posted on the MNC website and verify that ALL exterior modifications that you've made to your unit have been properly approved by the ARC Committee. The Architectural Guidelines specify which exterior modifications require approval.


